**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 14-102**  
**NON-METALLIC MINE OPERATOR'S LICENSE ORDINANCE**

The Town Board of the Town of Rice Lake, located in Barron County, Wisconsin, enacted on August 11, 2014 Ordinance No. 14-102 entitled "Non-metallic Mine Operator's License Ordinance" The Ordinance shall provide the Town of Rice Lake licensing authority over nonmetallic mining operations and processing plants related to nonmetallic mining, and regulate the effects they may have on the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Town of Rice Lake, Barron County, including air quality and water quality concerns; potential impact to the infrastructure of the town, property values, and the local economy. This ordinance shall take effect the day after the date of publication or posting as provided by Wis.
