NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town Board of The Town of Rice Lake, located in Barron County, Wisconsin, has enacted on June 8, 2015, Ordinance No. 15-104 entitled, "Ordinance Relating to the Regulation of Barking Dogs or Crying Cats." The ordinance amends the Town of Rice Lake's Public Nuisance Ordinance by declaring a dog or a cat to be a public nuisance if it habitually barks, howls, yelps, or cries, to the great discomfort of the peace and quiet of the neighborhood or in such manner as to materially disturb or annoy persons in the neighborhood, and the owners shall be subject to penalties.
