PLEASE SEPARATE RECYCLABLE ITEMS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. **PLASTICS:** #1 through #7 drained and rinsed with <u>caps on</u>, including pesticide, herbicide, or automotive products. Plastic bags contained within one bag and tied shut.
- 2. GLASS: White, Green and Brown. Caps off, labels left on, and rinsed out clean.
- 3. **NEWSPAPER:** Bundled together.
- 4. SHINY AND MIXED PAPER: Weekly advertising flyers (if stapled like a book submit with magazines & catalogs see #5 below), all grades of paper, white, colored, carbonless, envelopes (including windowed, labeled and craft), computer printout paper, file folders, post-it notes, junk mail. Bundled together.

DO NOT INCLUDE soiled or contaminated paper such as napkins, paper plates, hand towels or other paper products from rest rooms, carbon paper, cellophane or any waxed paper.

- 5. **MAGAZINES AND CATALOGS:** Includes paper that is bound or stapled, books, glued pads or tablets, spiral notebooks. Bundled together.
- 6. **CARDBOARD:** Corrugated and pressed cardboard such as cereal boxes, etc. Flaps opened and boxes folded flat and tied.
- 7. ALUMINUM: Cans and scrap aluminum.
- 8. **TIN AND OTHER SCRAP METAL:** Tin cans should have labels removed, flattened and rinsed out **clean**.
- 9. WHITE GOODS & ELECTRONICS: (Stoves, refrigerators, TV's, microwaves, computers, monitors, printers, etc.) The Town has an annual White Goods day held in April of each year. Watch the Early Bird for notice.

10. DRY CELL BATTERIES: Sizes A, AA, AAA, C, D, 9V

DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING AT CENTER WHEN THE CENTER IS NOT OPEN OR YOU MAY BE FINED.
