

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF LAND DIVISION ORDINANCE
BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RICE LAKE.

The Town Board of the Town of Rice Lake, located in Barron County, Wisconsin, enacted on May 9, 2011 Ordinance No. 11-102 entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Land Divisions, Subdivisions and Planning in the Town of Rice Lake, Wisconsin." The Ordinance sets forth a comprehensive set of regulations relating to land divisions occurring within the Town of Rice Lake, by means of platting or other mapping; and requires any person seeking to develop lands, to go through an approval process involving the town plan commission and the Town Board. The Ordinance also sets forth requirements relating to construction of necessary public improvements required as a condition of any such land division, technical design standards, financial requirements and related matters.
